NOTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED ST HELENA COMMUNITY WIND FARM DEVELOPMENT, WESTERN CAPE PROVINCE

Just Energy has lodged an application for environmental authorisation, with the national Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations GNR 544, GNR 545 and GNR 546 for the proposed St Helena Community Windfarm Development in the Western Cape Province.

Just Energy is proposing to establish a community wind farm and associated infrastructure with the Seeland Development Trust on Langeklip Farm (Erf 47) near St Helena Bay in the Saldanha Bay Municipality, Western Cape Province. The proposed St Helena Community Wind Farm Development is expected to generate approximately 30 Megawatts (MW) of electricity and will comprise of between 10 to 35 wind turbines. Associated infrastructure will include on-site transformers and control equipment buildings, access roads connecting the various turbines and for use on site during construction and electrical cables connecting the turbines to proposed a new substation site where the connecting cables will link into the electricity grid through a possible overhead powerline into the existing overhead Eskom powerlines.

Arcus GIBB (Pty) Ltd (GIBB) has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to compile the application and undertake the required Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Process. As part of the Public Participation Process (PPP) component of the EIA, Arcus GIBB has prepared the attached Background Information Document (BID) to inform all potential Interested and/or Affected Parties (I&APs) of the proposed project and provide details on how I&APs can register to be kept up to date on the EIA process and its findings.
