	WELCOME & INTRODUCTION
1.1.	KM welcomed all attendees.
1.2.	AB thanked all I&APs for the opportunity to interact with GIBB and indicated that all comments and communication from I&APs are regarded as high priority and would therefore like for this meeting to be as interactive possible.
2.	PURPOSE OF THE MEETING
2.1.	AB indicated that the purpose of the meeting was to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Present and actively introduce the public to the proposed project and the project team and; • Provide further detail with regards to the project as well as provide the public with an opportunity to actively participate in the Environmental authorisation process.
3.	PROJECT PRESENTATION
3.1.	AB provided background on the proposed project in that Eskom has submitted an application for Environmental authorisation by way of a Basic Assessment Process for the proposed construction of the Zandkopsdrift 132kV powerline from the proposed Hoekklip substation (Western Cape Province) to the Zandkopsdrift mine (Northern Cape Province).

3.2.	<p>AB provided information about the Public Participation Process which commenced on 12 November 2013. The public participation activities undertaken as part of the BA to date were as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advertisement in the local newspaper – Ons Kontrei on 18 October 2013; • Site Notices placed at conspicuous places on 21 October 2013 • Distribution of announcement letters to I&APs on 08 November 2013 • Distribution of the Draft Basic Assessment Report for public comment from 12 November 2013 to 10 January 2014; and • Public Meeting held (13 November 2013)
4.	DISCUSSION
4.1.	<p>Mr CA de Beer expressed his concerns in that one of the project specialists entered his property without any prior arrangement made to do so, during the June 2013 site visit. He further mentioned that a formal request was made by all landowners at the start of the project that prior arrangements to enter private property must be made by specialists before conducting their site visits.</p> <p><i>AB responded that the landowners' request was communicated to all specialists during the project start-up meetings held with each one individually and apologised for the lack of communication and inconvenience caused by the specialist in that he did not communicate his comings and goings with the landowners affected.</i></p>
4.2.	<p>Mr CH. de Beer indicated that his farm is located in close proximity to the proposed route alignment, but he has not yet been contacted by ESKOM to negotiate consideration in the event of the line crossing his property. As far as he could see on the maps provided by ESKOM, the proposed powerline will cross over a small corner of his farm.</p> <p><i>AB indicated that ESKOM alone deals with all the landowner negotiations and discussions around consideration with regards to the powerline crossing over farm land. She requested that all the I&APs present at the meeting must include their farm names, numbers and portion numbers on the attendance register to ensure that they are registered and kept informed of the process.</i></p>
4.3.	<p>Mr CH de Beer requested clarity with regards to the proposed and alternative route alignments and how the powerline will be accessed for maintenance purposes.</p> <p><i>AB responded indicating that ESKOM specifically designed the route alignments so that the powerline will be easily accessible for maintenance purposes. She confirmed that existing farm roads will be used as far as possible to access the powerline and that by doing so, will reduce the amount of impacts on the surrounding environment compared to creating entirely new access roads.</i></p>
4.4.	<p>Mr CA de Beer requested clarity in whether all affected landowners will be compensated for the full 300m corridor applied for by ESKOM?</p> <p><i>TN and OP replied indicating that although ESKOM has applied for a 300m corridor, only 31m within the 300m will be the registered servitude (15m on each side of the powerline). The 300m corridor applied for will allow ESKOM to move the pylons around in that space as the exact</i></p>

	<p><i>location of each pylon will only be confirmed during the construction period.</i></p> <p><i>Therefore, all landowners will only be compensated for the 31m servitude.</i></p>
4.5.	<p>Mr CA de Beer requested whether ESKOM will pay for a bigger servitude than 31m when for example, there are two servitudes adjacent to each other, and the land in between is too small for them to use. Do they lose this land or will ESKOM pay for this strip as well?</p> <p><i>OP responded by stating that ESKOM cannot pay for land that they are not registering nor using, however this will be discussed on a case by case basis.</i></p>
4.6.	<p>Mr Johan Van Hoven reiterated the need to clearly document all consideration matters brought to light by the affected landowners. He then furthermore expressed his concerns regarding the impacts on traffic and security during the construction and operational phases of the project. He requested that ESKOM takes all of these matters into consideration and implement the required mitigation measures to be adhered to during the construction and operational phases of the project. Mr Van Hoven also requested that ESKOM consult with the Farm watch prior to construction so to ensure effective communication between all parties.</p> <p><i>AB responded that his comment is noted and that ESKOM will consult with the Farm watch closer to an appropriate time.</i></p>
4.7.	<p>Mr C.A de Beer requested clarity whether ESKOM will be constructing gates along the routes where they need to access the powerline for maintenance purposes? He indicated that he does not want ESKOM to drive past his house and through his fields when carrying out maintenance on the powerline, and would therefore request that they construct their own private access gate and keep it locked at all times.</p> <p><i>AB responded that his comment is noted and that ESKOM will indeed be constructing their own private gates for access to the powerline for maintenance purposes where the existing access cannot be used in the event of a landowner requesting otherwise.</i></p> <p><i>OP confirmed that the servitude agreement that Eskom will sign with the landowners make provision for the right to use existing roads and gates that give access to the property to the powerline and also to erect gates where necessary. He also confirmed that Eskom shall ensure that all gates used will be kept closed and locked at all times.</i></p>
4.8.	<p>Mr CA de Beer requested that all landowners must be contacted telephonically and kept updated with the status of the Basic Assessment process. He also requested that all correspondence going forward on the project be in Afrikaans.</p> <p><i>AB indicated that all I&APs on the database were phoned prior to the Public Open day, informing them of the availability of the draft BAR and Public Open day to be held at the Landplaas community hall.</i></p> <p><i>She then lastly confirmed that the registered I&APs on the project will be contacted telephonically going forward to update them on the progress of the project and availability of the final BAR via progress letters which will be in Afrikaans.</i></p>
4.9.	<p>Mr Johan Van Hovan thanked GIBB and Eskom for the presentation and interaction thus far with the public regarding the project. He indicated that GIBB's communication with the public follows due process and that this is a lot better than the communication they have received from consultants related to other ESKOM projects in the area.</p>
4.10.	<p>Mr C.A de Beer requested clarity on the quality of the drainage lines identified by the aquatic specialist and also wanted to know where the ~50 to ~70 drainage lines are located as he is not aware of them?</p>

	<p><i>AB responded that the drainage lines are mostly caused by erosion and will only have flowing water during certain times of the year when the area receives high rainfall. She also indicated that most of these drainage lines are dry during most part of the year due to the very low rainfall in the arid region.</i></p> <p><i>AB lastly confirmed that a Water Use License Application will be applied for as all drainage lines need to be taken into consideration, irrelevant of whether they have flowing water or not.</i></p>
5.	CLOSURE AND WAY FORWARD
5.1.	<p>AB formally thanked the public for their participation and closed the Public meeting at 09h50 by confirming that no issues were raised during the meeting that were not answered or clarified during the meeting itself and would thus see that as a sign of no objection from the public against the project.</p> <p>AB reminded all to submit their comments on the project to the Public Participation Office (details provided at the meeting and previous engagement) before 10 January 2014, as their inputs are highly appreciated and will be incorporated in the final BAR.</p>

3.2.	<p>AB verskaf inligting in verband met die Publieke Deelname Proses wat begin het op 12 November 2013. 4.	BESPREKING
4.1.	<p>Mnr CA de Beer het dit bekend gemaak dat een van die projek spesialiste sonder enige voorafgaande reëling, sy grond betree het gedurende die Junie 2013 besoek. Hy het verder genoem dat 'n formele versoek deur alle grondeienaars aan die begin van die projek gemaak was dat reëlings vooraf getref moet word deur spesialiste voor die afneem van hul besoek.</p> <p><i>AB het geantwoord dat alle spesialiste in kennis gestel was van die grondeienaars se versoek en dat alle kontakbesonderhede van hierdie grondeienaars aan die spesialiste verskaf was. Sy het verder om verskoning gevra vir die gebrek aan kommunikasie en ongerief wat veroorsaak was deur die spesialis.</i></p>
4.2.	<p>Mnr CH de Beer het aangedui dat sy plaas naby geleë is aan die voorgestelde roete aanpassing en dat die kraglyn oor 'n gedeelte van sy plaas gaan strek. Hy was tot dusver nog nie gekontak deur Eskom om te onderhandel in terme van die vergoeding vir die gebruik van sy grond.nie en wou dus weet of dit nog sou gebeur?</p> <p><i>AB antwoord toe dat Eskom alleenlik alle grondeienaar onderhandelinge en gesprekke met betrekking tot die kraglyn kruisings hanteer. Sy versoek toe dat alle B&GPe teenwoordig by die vergadering hul plaas name, nommers en gedeelte nommers op die bywoningsregistrer sal aandui sodat hul op hoogte gehou kan word met alle verwickelinge in verband met die projek.</i></p>
4.3.	<p>Mnr CH de Beer versoek duidelikheid met betrekking tot die voorgestelde en alternatiewe roete aanpassings, asook die toeganklikheid tot die kraglyn tydens instandhouding prosedures.</p> <p><i>AB antwoord toe dat albei roetes spesifiek ontwerp was deur ESKOM om maklike toegang tot die kraglyn te hê tydens instandhouding prosedures. Sy bevestig toe ook dat die alle bestaande plaaspaaie so ver moontlik gebruik sal word vir hierdie prosedures om sodoende die aantal impakte te verminder op die omliggende omgewing.</i></p>
4.4.	<p>Mnr CA de Beer versoek duidelikheid of alle direk geaffekteerde grondeienaars vergoed sal word vir die volle 300m deurgang wat voor aansoek gedoen is deur ESKOM?</p> <p><i>TN en OP antwoord toe dat alhoewel Eskom 'n aansoek ingedien het vir 'n 300m deurgang, slegs 31m binne die 300m geregistreer sal word as 'n ESKOM serwitut (15m aan beide kante van die kraglyn). Die 300m deurgang laat Eskom dus net toe om die kragpale rond te beweeg in die ruimte, aangesien die presiese ligging van elke kragpaal nie op die huidige oomblik bevestig kan word nie.
