B. APPEAL PROCEDURE

i. Notice of Intent to Appeal to DEDEAT

If any I&APs wish to lodge an appeal against the Environmental Authorisation, they must lodge a *Notice of Intention to appeal in writing* to the MEC for Economic Development and Environmental Affairs and Tourism in terms of Regulation 60(1) of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2010, within twenty (20) days after this notification.

Notice of intention to appeal (*original document*) must be submitted in writing to the Minister of Environmental Affairs within 20 days of this notification by means of the following methods:

ii. Notice of Intent to Appeal to Applicant



iii. Appeal submission deadline and form

The appeal submission must reach the MEC within 30 days of lodging the *Notice of Intention to appeal*, on an official form published by or obtainable from the relevant DEA department. The appeal submission must be accompanied by:

1. A statement setting out the grounds of appeal;
2. Supporting documentation which is referred to in the appeal and which is not in the possession of the MEC;
3. A statement by the appellant that regulation 62(2) or (3) has been complied with together with copies of the notices referred to in that regulation.
