**EIA 12/12/20/1887: CONSTRUCTION OF THE DTP TRADEZONE TO WATSON HIGHWAY
LINK ROAD – ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING REPORT**

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Draft Environmental Scoping Report dated November 2010.

Tongaat Hulett, an agri-processing business with integrated component of land management and property development, owns land in the vicinity of the proposed development site and therefore has an interest in the proposed development.

Tongaat Hulett (TH) supports the proposed link road between the DTP and uShukela Drive as it will provide an important, direct access to the TradePort for particularly freight purposes. We are of the view that it is a critical piece of infrastructure that will add tremendous value to the TradePort as well as to the region.

At a principle level, we are supporting of Alternative 1 due to its sustainability principles and would encourage the use of eg solar powered lighting along the road as a further example of sustainability being implemented.

It is noted that TH is, together with DubeTradePort, undertaking the planning and EIA process for the precinct of land adjacent to the new link road and there are a few issues in this regard to be acknowledged:-

- Sufficient access points onto the link road are required
- The existing drainage systems that the road will cross will need to be accommodated in the most appropriate manner
- The traffic impact of the road needs to be carefully considered and modeled, particularly in regard to whether the road is also utilised to access the Passenger Terminal and the potential impact of the uShukela Highway Development.
- The potential implementation of a Public Transportation system through the airport which appears to have been accommodated but it is unclear as to whether



As you are aware, the Dube TradePort (DTP) proposes to construct a new 3.5 kilometre (km) long road to link the DTP Trade Zone (adjacent to the King Shaka International Airport within the DTP) to the Watson Highway (recently renamed uShukela Drive) to the north. Dear Rashieda Dauids, Please note my apologies should I not be able to make it to tonight's meeting .
My area of concern is,

- The proposed dual lane roadway from DTP/KSIA into a single lane road- the Watson/Ushukela highway.
- Watson highway during peak times does get clogged.
- Could the developer not build a separate service road parallel to the south side of the Watson highway with only a link at the N2 ramp-on/off point. or convert the existing section of the Watson highway into a dual lane one-way and build the opposite two lanes on the other side of the trees lining the south side of the existing roadway. The scenic route must be maintained at all costs.
- Will there be a link from the proposed new highway to hospital hill road via the klipfontein area.

I do believe that this will result in a better long term solution avoiding an impending traffic problem for the residents of Tongaat and the beach area.

I have to say that the design of the proposed dual lane roadway , including bicycle and pedestrian pavements is welcomed. I shall be making the same suggestion to KSEMS with regards to the Ushukela business park development.
