### Newborn baby murdered by mother

**Creswell Park** — A murder of the most heart-wrenching kind took place locally just three days after Christmas.

According to Rondepoort SAPS communications official, Captain Siphwe Ndlovu, a 20-year-old mother initially tried to conceal the birth of her premature baby in Creswell Park.

"A person in the area called police and it was discovered that the baby had been thrown through a window by the mother who was only seven months pregnant at the time of giving birth.

"The child was taken to Coronation Hospital," says Ndlovu.

According to ER24 communications official, Riana Tzech, the baby was born at 3am, and was

found naked in the grass outside the hostel.

"The baby was treated for frostbite and had a laceration on his cheek.

"The child was thrown through the window because the mother, who lives with her aunt at the hostel, was afraid of her parents' disapproval."

Unfortunately, according to Ndlovu, the child later passed away.

"The mother was to be charged with concealment of birth, but now the charges include murder.

"She has appeared in court already and her case was postponed until 22 January. She was not granted bail and has been remanded in custody."

### Elderly man missing in Davidsonville

**Davidsonville** — On 12 December the Smith family's festive season took a turn for the worse when 70-year-old family member Piet Abdullah went missing.

"He was last seen wearing a blue blazer, a white striped shirt and light brown shoes," says Cathy Smith, Piet's daughter.

"We were here, visiting us from Hartswater, and he doesn't know anyone else here or his anywhere to go."

According to the Smiths, Piet was in good health for a mental condition.

The family has opened a missing persons case with the Rondepoort SAPS but appeals to the public to assist them with their search.

According to the Rondepoort SAPS, the

following procedure should be followed in the event of a person going missing. The person must be reported missing at the nearest SAPS station immediately. There is no waiting period. A SAPS form must be completed and a detailed description of the missing person, where it is believed they went missing, as well as a recent photograph if possible.

An Acceptance of Liability is also required. This indemnifies the SAPS from any claims arising from publication of the information. The report and photograph, when sent to the Bureau of Missing Persons, where they are published.

### Public helps in the arrest of rapists

**Matholeville** — Two wanted rape and robbery suspects were arrested by police on 3 January, after police received assistance from a member of the community.

According to Rondepoort SAPS communications official, Captain Siphwe Ndlovu, a rape and robbery case was opened last year in June, following an incident in Davidsonville.

"With the help of a member of the community, investigating officer Constable Vuyisile Shwaba was able to trace the suspects to Matholeville, where they were arrested.

"The suspects are 27 and 20 years of age. This case is a good example of how the community and police can work together.

"The SAPS can not be more efficient than when members of the community, who live with criminals among them, assist the police with information.

"Please be assured that all information given to the police will always be treated as confidential."
