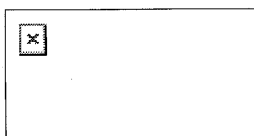

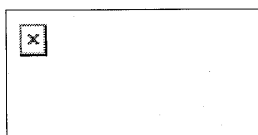
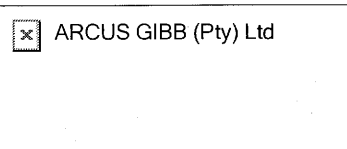

Thank you for your comments and your enthusiasm to be involved.

Kindly note that the Background Information Document (BID) sent to you only contains brief information on the proposed project as we are still in the early stages of the BA process and the project as a whole. We are therefore still collecting and collating information about the proposed project and therefore do not yet have all the answers or responses the issues and concerns you have raised. We will be compiling a detailed Basic Assessment Report (BAR), which will document and address all issues raised where relevant. The draft BAR will be made available to you to check our responses to your issues raised and to allow you to make further comments, should you have any. We have informed the proponent of your concerns so they can consider the issues and appropriate responses in their planning.

We acknowledge that your issues are related to the management of contractors, traffic and water interruptions. Please see our initial responses on these issues below.

- The proponent is aware that they need to consider feasible alternative route alignments for the proposed pipeline and have done so in identifying the proposed route. Descriptions of the alternatives considered and descriptions of their feasibility will be provided in the BA Report. Please note that the exact alignment still needs to be confirmed and may change with input from the BA process. Please also be aware that the eThekweni Water & Sanitation is making every effort to find a route that does not transverse private properties and hence have had to follow the only available route through their own property – namely the road servitudes.
- In terms of the alignment eThekweni Water & Sanitation intends to install the pipeline within the road reserve, no more than 3m away from property boundaries along the route. Installing the pipeline as far from the road traffic as possible will also aid to mitigate traffic interruptions. eThekweni Water & Sanitation has stated that the intention is to install 100m of the pipeline per week and to as far as possible avoid traversing driveways and verges.

- With regard to the pipeline running along Kassier Road, eThekweni Water & Sanitation has discussed this option with the Department of Transport (DoT) who are the authority for provincial roads such as Kassier Road. The DoT has stated that they intend to widen certain portions of Kassier Road in the future and it is therefore not feasible to install a pipeline within the Kassier Road servitude. However, a portion of the pipeline is planned to be installed along a small section of Kassier Road (between Acorn Grove and Assagay Road) as this is the only available route without having to cross through private properties. Kassier Road has therefore been omitted as a feasible alternative route.
- As noted in the BID, there is a demand for additional supply of water in the Summerhills area and the installation of a pipeline is pertinent to meet this demand. Unfortunately, water and traffic interruptions cannot completely be avoided when installing a water pipeline.


We hope that we have, to some degree, addressed your concerns at this early stage of the project. Please note that you will be informed of opportunities to receive and review the Draft BA Report and other relevant information as the BA process progresses.

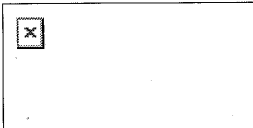

I wish to place on record our objection to the proposed route of the above water main.

Let us look at the proposed route as compared to going straight down Kassier Road objectively.
Hereunder points for and against both routes.

PROPOSED ROUTE:

- i) POINTS FOR: **NIL**
- ii) POINTS AGAINST:
 - a) Not economically viable.
 - b) Not logistically viable.
 - c) The distance straight down Kassier Road is almost half that of the proposed route.
i.e. 0,9 kilometres vs 1,6 kilometres.
 - d) Many very narrow areas down Assagay Crescent with major bends (**DANGEROUS**) whereas Kassier Road is dead straight for the majority of the way.
 - e) Kassier Road has only one driveway to cut across / all street lights are on the opposite side of the road / no residents verges / trees / driveway entrance hedges / walls / water or electricity cables to dig across / no electricity sub stations etc. (PLUS Kassier Road is due to be widened in the not too distant future so we are informed). **WHEREAS** the opposite is true on the proposed route (many driveways to dig up and fix plus cutting across Assagay Crescent etc. Most street lights are on this side of the road. Many trees planted

residents / all our verges which are kept in good condition by ourselves / walls e.g. Queensbridge Estate, Eskom sub station near the bottom of Assagay Crescent.

- f) Huge banks directly on the side of Assagay Crescent at the top and bottom sections, these are also on the VERY NARROW parts of the road with bends as well. **(This will create very dangerous situations).**
- g) Approximately 250 households will be **very badly inconvenienced** for goodness knows how long (roughly 90 at Silver Oaks, 90 at Queensbridge Estates, 60 single households and residents in Assagay Crescent, Steepleview Road, Glenmore Close, Church Road and Acorn Grove).
- h) The route from the junction of Alverstone Road / Assagay Crescent and down Assagay Crescent to Kassier Road is used as a short cut for parents taking and fetching their children to and from Waldorf school (a large number of which always seem to be in an extreme hurry and think Assagay Crescent is part of a race track).
- i) A 75mm water pipe was recently laid in our area and this caused untold hassles / mess for a period of approximately 6 months; can you imagine the problems a 400mm water pipe is going to cause!!!!

As an extremely concerned resident of the area I would like to know why this water main is taking such a round about route – inconveniencing an untold number of households. Would the more sensible route not be straight down Alverston Road and onto Kassier Road – which would cause the minimum amount of disruption to residence. One would assume that by doing this the work would be quicker – no driveways etc to dig up and as it is an extremely busy road, work might just be completed with some speed!

The small pipe line that was recently laid in this area was a nightmare for all concerned. Days with no water as pipes had been broken in the laying of the new one. Electricity disrupted for similar reasons. Days when no work was done at all and an unsightly mess left for us all to drive around. This small project took months to complete.

I wish to place on record my objection to the proposed route of the above water main.

- a) The distance straight down Kassier Road is almost half that of the proposed route.
i.e. 0,9 kilometres vs 1,6 kilometres.
- b) Many very narrow areas down Assagay Crescent with major bends whereas Kassier Road
is dead straight for the majority of the way.
- c) Kassier Road has only one driveway to cut across / all street lights are on the opposite side of the road /
no residents verges / trees / driveway entrance hedges / walls / water or electricity cables to dig across /
no electricity sub stations etc. (PLUS Kassier Road is due to be widened in the not too distant future so
we are informed). The opposite is true on the proposed route (many driveways to dig up and fix
plus cutting across Assagay Crescent etc. Most street lights are on this side of the road. Many trees planted
by
residents / all our verges which are kept in good condition by ourselves / walls e.g. Queensbridge Estate,
Eskom sub station near the bottom of Assagay Crescent.
- d) From an aesthetic point of view - Assagay crescent is lined with trees - which I would not like to see removed.
- e) Dangerous situations will result from construction along Assagay Crescent due to the steep banks on both
sides of the road especially where the road narrows and bends.
- f) Approximately 250 households will be **very badly inconvenienced** for the period that road will be under
construction - which if its anything like the road works recently done in our area - it could be a very long
time. (roughly 90 at Silver Oaks, 90 at Queensbridge Estates, 60 single households and residents in Assagay
Crescent, Steepleview Road, Glenmore Close, Church Road and Acorn Grove).
- g) A 75mm water pipe was recently laid in our area and this caused untold hassles / mess for a period of
approximately 6 months; I am sure it will be worse for a 400mm pipe.
- h) We suffer from regular power cuts in our area without any construction near our substation - my concern is that
this becomes a more frequent occurrence - worse than it is now due to digging in and around our power cables.
- i) The roads in our area - especially Assagay Crescent - are in a bad state - potholed etc. without the increased
numbers of heavy duty vehicles which would be inevitable with the laying of this pipeline - resulting in the further
deterioration of the roads.
- j) An influx of contractors in the area always results in an increase in crime in the area.

The proposed route down Assagay Crescent does not make sense due to the following factors.

- Many very narrow areas down Assagay Crescent with major bends and blind rises which will be of extreme danger to the residence of the area.
- Huge banks and verges which again play claim to a very narrow road which currently is difficult to pass on coming vehicles.

Surely based on the road infrastructure it would make far more sense to use the alternative route of Kassier RD.

I had gone back to the client for answers to your questions and drafted my response a week ago. My apologies for not sending this email it sooner.

We thank you for your comments and assure you that ALL comments received by Arcus GIBB related to this project follow a process whereby the comments are logged, documented, evaluated and incorporated into the Draft Basic Assessment (BA) Report, with your actual email attached in a separate appendix. In this way the original comments are recorded and submitted to the 'Decision Makers' with no alteration or omissions. It is our aim to ensure that all comments are recorded and responded to.

Please be aware that we are still in the early stages of the BA process and the project as a whole. We are therefore still collecting and collating information about the proposed project and therefore do not yet have all the answers or responses to some of the issues and concerns raised.

eThekwini Water & Sanitation, the client, is aware that they need to consider feasible alternative route alignments. Descriptions of alternatives and reasons for inclusion or dismissal of identified alternatives will be provided in the BA Report. With regard to the pipeline running along Kassier Road, eThekwini has discussed this option with the

Department of Transport (DoT), who are in charge of the road reserve on Kassier Road. The DoT has stated that they intend to widen certain portions of Kassier Road in the future and it is therefore not feasible to install a pipeline there.

The pipeline is intended to tie-in at the intersection of Gevers and Assagay Roads and also connect to the existing 400 mm water main in Fraser Road.

At present, eThekweni intends to install the pipeline within the road reserve, no more than 3m away from property boundaries along the route. Driveways and certain roads would be traversed along the route. Please note that the exact alignment still needs to be confirmed and may change with input from the BA process.

Thanks you for your general notification letter dated 23/04/2009.

As an affected resident of the proposed trunk water main along Assagay Crescent, please will you register me as an IAP. I object strongly to the proposed rout of this pipeline for the following reasons:

1. Off D435, Assagay Crescent is a narrow and twisting road with small verges. In its current state it cannot safely take much traffic, let alone with major pipeline excavation and construction works.
2. About two years ago the relatively minor residential water pipes were upgraded, which disrupted traffic flow and access for months, so a major pipeline construction will be a disaster and a safety hazard on an already dangerous road.
3. Assagay Crescent takes a lot of traffic from several local complexes as well as Roseway Waldorf School. It is already a problem to negotiate Assagay Crescent at peak times, which will only be exacerbated by any pipeline works.
4. The more direct route (and thus cheaper) would be along Kassier Road.
5. Residential properties along Kassier road are nearly all large plots and situated well back from the road, unlike those on Assagay Crescent, and thus Kassier Road will accommodate with ease construction of the proposed pipeline.
6. Upgrading of Kassier Road is scheduled to take place in the near future, which would be an ideal time to simultaneously make provision for the proposed 400 mm trunk water main.

I would greatly appreciate it if you could keep me fully informed of all BA and PPP processes, as well as supplying me with all relevant reports, especially those pertaining to potential alternative routes.

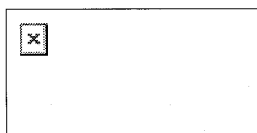
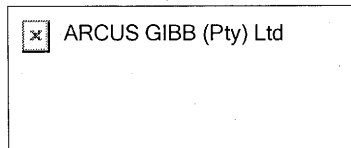

I wish to place on record our objection to the proposed route of the above water main.

Let us look at the proposed route as compared to going straight down Kassier Road objectively. Hereunder points for and against both routes.

PROPOSED ROUTE:

i) POINTS FOR: **NIL**

ii) POINTS AGAINST:

- a) Not economically viable.
- b) Not logistically viable.
- c) The distance straight down Kassier Road is almost half that of the proposed route.
i.e. 0,9 kilometres vs 1,6 kilometres.
- d) Many very narrow areas down Assagay Crescent with major bends (**DANGEROUS**) whereas Kassier Road is dead straight for the majority of the way.
- e) Kassier Road has only one driveway to cut across / all street lights are on the opposite side of the road / no residents verges / trees / driveway entrance hedges / walls / water or electricity cables to dig across / no electricity sub stations etc. (PLUS Kassier Road is due to be widened in the not too distant future so we are informed). **WHEREAS** the opposite is true on the proposed route (many driveways to dig up and fix plus cutting across Assagay Crescent etc. Most street lights are on this side of the road. Many trees planted by residents / all our verges which are kept in good condition by ourselves / walls e.g. Queensbridge Estate, Eskom sub station near the bottom of Assagay Crescent.
- f) Huge banks directly on the side of Assagay Crescent at the top and bottom sections, these are also on the **VERY NARROW** parts of the road with bends as well. (**This will create very dangerous situations**).
- g) Approximately 250 households will be **very badly inconvenienced** for goodness knows how long (roughly 90 at Silver Oaks, 90 at Queensbridge Estates, 60 single households and residents in Assagay Crescent, Steepleview Road, Glenmore Close, Church Road and Acorn Grove).
- h) The route from the junction of Alverstone Road / Assagay Crescent and down Assagay Crescent to Kassier Road is used as a short cut for parents taking and fetching their children to and from Waldorf school (a large number of which always seem to be in an extreme hurry and think Assagay Crescent is part of a race track).
- i) A 75mm water pipe was recently laid in our area and this caused untold hassles / mess for a period of
