Notice is hereby given that the KZN Department of Transport (DoT) has lodged an application for environmental authorisation with the National Department of Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEAT) in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations (Regulations in terms of Chapter 5 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998, as amended) for the proposed upgrading of the Sani Pass Road (P318) - Phase 2.

ARCUS GIBB has been appointed as the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to compile the application and undertake the associated Scoping and EIA Process.

Project details:

The DoT proposes to upgrade the existing Sani Pass Road (P318) from gravel to a hardened surface. The first phase of this upgrade (km 0 – km 14) has already been approved and is currently under construction. This EIA relates to the proposed development of Phase 2 of the project, namely the upgrading of the remaining 19kms, from km 14 to km 33 at the summit (Lesotho border). The proposed upgrade involves the complete grading and resurfacing of the P318 including some road re-alignment and widening, construction of new bridges, stormwater control and attenuation systems, bank and slope stabilisation measures and road servitude rehabilitation.
